

## **Important Information for People Wishing to Comment on this Project**

Public comments are invited on the *Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement for the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest Land and Resource Management Plan to Comply with the District Court Order (Bighorn Sheep)*. Forest Supervisor Melany Glossa is the Responsible Official for this project. The Draft SEIS and all appendices are available on our web page at <http://www.fs.usda.gov/project/?project=50067>. Printed copies are available upon request.

The 90-day public comment period begins the day after the Notice of Availability is published in the November 10, 2016 Federal Register (also published at the above web page).

It is important that reviewers provide comments at such times and in such a way they are useful to the Agency's preparation of the Final SEIS. Comments should be provided prior to the close of the comment period and should clearly articulate the reviewer's concerns and contentions. The submission of timely and specific comments can affect a reviewer's ability to participate in subsequent administrative or judicial review.
