

## Entiat – Preston Fox

**Description:** This area was burned in the 1971, and was salvaged logged resulting in an extensive road system. Most of the invasive plants are found along the roads.

**Infested acres:** 17

**Total acres:** 18,762

**5<sup>th</sup> Field watershed:** Entiat River

**Major Streams and Waterbodies:** Entiat River, Preston, Fox, Dill, Brennegan, McCrea and Burns Creeks.

**Elevation:** 1400-3000ft

**Vegetation Type:** dry ponderosa pine/Douglas fir forest, mixed conifer forest.

**Soils:** Sandy Loam with a pumice/ash component

**Precipitation:** 30-40 inches/year

**Special Management Areas:** Research Forest

**Recreation:** dispersed camping, hiking, hunting, snowmobiling, motorcycle, horseback, and mountain bike riding.

**Grazing:** none

**TES, ISSSP plant species:** none known

**Other land Ownerships:** private

**Vectors of spread:** Vehicle traffic, recreational use, wildlife, wind.

**Ongoing Treatments:** Spot spraying of road side infestations of Dalmatian toadflax and spotted and diffuse knapweed.

**IWM Strategy:** Monitor for new invaders..
