

Wenatchee River – Wenatchee River

Description: The Wenatchee River watershed is over fifty percent wilderness. There are two trailheads and one developed campground. Highway 2, a major travel corridor, runs adjacent to the Wenatchee River through the scenic Tumwater Canyon.

Soils: Silt loam, Fine sandy loam, Sandy loam, Loamy fine sand, Loam

Special Management Areas: Alpine Lakes Wilderness, Tumwater Botanical Area, Special Interest Area - Scenic

Recreation: Hiking, climbing, mountain biking, fishing, hunting, camping, backpacking,

Ongoing Treatments: Manual control at trailheads, chemical treatment on roadsides

IWM Strategy: Monitor for new species and/or infestations and treat either manually or chemically; control existing infestations.
