


South George Project Planning Area - Inventory of Potential Wilderness Areas

Depicts forest roads. PWA boundaries were located 300 feet either side of semi-permanent, human made forest roads to facilitate easy on-the-ground identification. This boundary also excludes stumps created by road construction, danger tree maintenance, and personal-use firewood gathering. (FSH 1909. 12 ch.71 and 71.11 (9)).

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
