The Forest Service is seeking comments on the Smith River National Recreation Area (NRA) Restoration & Motorized Travel Management Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS). The purpose of the project is to make changes to the National Forest Transportation System, and to restore select unauthorized routes on the Gasquet Ranger District in Del Norte County, California. The DEIS is available for review at the Gasquet Ranger District Office, 10600 Highway 199, Gasquet, CA, and at the Six Rivers National Forest Supervisor's Office, 1330 Bayshore Way, Eureka, CA; or, on-line at: <http://www.fs.usda.gov/goto/srnf/srnra>

This project is subject to comment pursuant to 36 CFR 218, Subparts A and B. Planning for this project began under the appeal process (36 CFR 215). As of this date, it is instead subject to the objection process (36 CFR 218). Only those who submit timely project-specific written comments during a public comment period are eligible to file an objection. Individuals or representatives of an entity submitting comments must sign the comments or verify identity upon request.

The Forest Service will accept comments on this proposal for 60 days following publication of the Notice of Availability (NOA) in the Federal Register which is the exclusive means for calculating the comment period. The Federal Register publication of the NOA occurred on April 11, 2014. The Commenters should not rely upon dates or timeframe information provided by any other source. It is the commenter's responsibility to ensure timely receipt of comments (36 CFR 218.25).
