As the Responsible Official, for the Pacific Northwest Electronic Warfare Range Environmental Assessment (EA), I've decided to extend the current public comment. The office business hours for those submitting hand-delivered comments are: 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding holidays. Those submitting electronic copies must put the project name in the subject line, and must either submit comments as part of the e-mail message or as an attachment only in one of the following three formats: Microsoft Word, rich text format (rtf) or Adobe Portable Document Format (pdf). In cases where no identifiable name is attached to a comment, a verification of identity will be required for objection eligibility. If using an electronic message, a scanned signature is one way to provide verification.

Written, facsimile, hand-delivered, and electronic comments concerning this action will be accepted until November 28, 2014.
